# MINUTES OF NORTH SALEM REVITALIZATION INC. NOVEMBER 16, 2022

#### 7. OTHER

All thought it was a good idea; Aimee will set google form for registration, open from December 1<sup>st</sup> and close January 7<sup>th</sup>; Aimee will also put out on social media. Prize could be a nice ladle and bragging rights. More planning to be done.
