

**MINUTES OF
NORTH SALEM REVITALIZATION INC.
MAY 14, 2025**

1. CALL TO ORDER:

Beth and Tammy will mark vendor spots and parking spots on the Friday before. Food prices were discussed and finalized (see attached). We need to put up some kind of detour sign on SR 75 and CR 500 showing people how to get into town. We will be getting tables and chairs from the Methodist Church. Aimee has circulated a sign up sheet for volunteers. We will begin preparing strawberries at the Methodist Church on Thursday, May 29th at 1:00 if anyone would like to help!!!! It's a BIG job!

6. NEW BUSINESS

- A. We have amended the bylaws to combine the Secretary/Treasurer position. Beth will fill this position and Holly will be a Board Member.

7. OTHER

- A. Aimee received a quote from Tate Concrete for the handicap pad at the park. It came in at \$5,300.00 and it's even bigger – 30x36. The Pressley Concrete quote was for a 20x36 at around \$5,800.00. It was decided to go with Tate but some time after the Festival.
- B. Also after the Festival we will work on the mulch and stuff for the little library at the Christian Church.

8. ADJOURNMENT

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 7:20 pm. Our next meeting will be June 11th at 6:30 in the Town Hall.
